Mounted inside a framed cabinet, the authenticated team autographs include the **2013 Boston Bruins Stanley Cup** finalist players **Zdeno Chara, Jaromir Jagr, Patrice Bereron, David Krejci, Milan Lucic** and of course **Dan Paille**.

Raised in Welland, Ontario, Daniel played his minor hockey with his hometown Welland Tigers. He played junior hockey for the Guelph Storm and was also a member of Team Canada for the 2003 world Junior Ice Hockey Championships and the Team Canada captain for the 2004 World Junior Ice Hockey Championships, winning silver medals in both tournaments. Daniel joined the Boston Bruins in 2009 where he plays the left wing position.
